following your request, we can state that the inks

- J-NEXT SUBLY MAGENTA
- J-NEXT SUBLY CYAN
- J-NEXT SUBLY ABSOLUTE BLACK
- J-NEXT SUBLY YELLOW
- J-NEXT SUBLY ABSOLUTE BLACK TP

do not contain intentionally any substance included into the California Proposition List.

By the other hands, we must inform you that in our inks there are some raw materials which can develop a very low quantity of Formaldehyde, and this substance is listed in California Proposition 65.

Anyway, we can state that after the printing and heat transfer the formaldehyde is not present on the articles. We strongly suggest you take action, through vacuum system, to the safe removal of vapours emitted during the process of transfer, as required by good industrial practice.

The attention must be paid for the workers occupational exposure while using our inks. The employer must provide proper information to their employees through labels to be affixed to products, workplace sign or other information channels as established by the California Hazard Communication Standard.
